Able to walk on command, no major injuries. MINOR

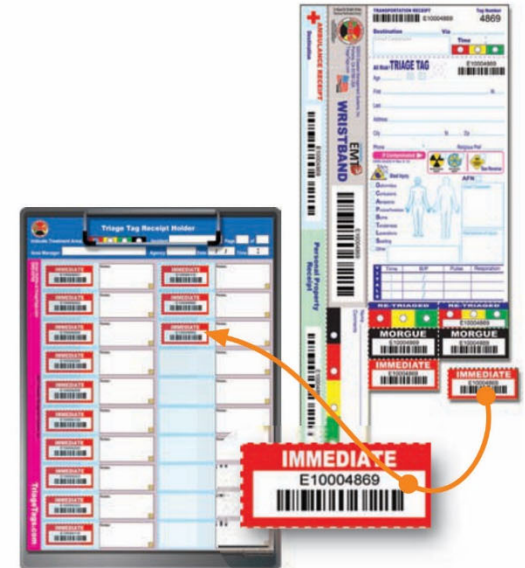
Mechanism of Injury area
