








Directions For Use



1. Identify the source of bleeding. Clear as much blood as possible from the wound site prior to application.




2. Tear open pouch and unscrew empty package.



3. Pack gauze into the wound opening atop the applied gel.

cap. Insert syringe deep into wound as close to bleeding source as possible. Firmly and quickly expel all contents into the wound. Keep

4. Apply moderate palm compression, covering as much surface area as possible. Continue compression for three (3) minutes or until hemostasis is achieved. Avoid ejecting any of the underlying gel. Apply additional gauze if needed. Show empty package to medical personnel.

To remove TRAUMAGEL®:

A. TRAUMAGEL® must be removed within 24 hours of application.

B. Remove all the gel using gauze and/or thorough irrigation.

Contraindications: TRAUMAGEL® is not intended for surgical use. TRAUMAGEL® is not intended to be used as a wound-closure device.

Warnings:

- 1. Do not apply TRAUMAGEL® on junctional wounds not amenable to pressure.
- 2. Do not apply TRAUMAGEL® unless the source of bleeding is easily visible. Do not blindly apply TRAUMAGEL®.
- 3. Do not use TRAUMAGEL® on penetrating injuries of the chest or abdomen.
